REGULAR MEETING NO. 27 Room 108, City Hall October 17, 2023 5:30 O'Clock P.M.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 P.M.

Present were Council Member Roe, Galloway, McAntire, Hull, and Mayor Johnson. Council Member Pope was absent.

Roe moved, seconded by Galloway to enter into closed session in accordance with IA Code Section 21.5(1)(c). To discuss strategy with counsel in matters that are presently in litigation or where litigation is imminent where its disclosure would be likely to prejudice or disadvantage the position of the governmental body in that litigation. Motion carried 4-1. Absent: Pope.

The meeting entered closed session at 5:31 P.M.

Galloway moved, seconded by Roe to return to open session at 5:53 P.M. Motion carried 4-1. Absent: Pope.

Council reconvened at 6:00 P.M. in Council Chambers.

Committee, term to exp. 10/1/2024 due to vacancy; Canvasser/Solicitor application for Workingman's Christmas Party Oct. 29 to Dec. 31, 2023; Res. No. 168-2023, fixing Nov. 7, 2023 as date for public hearing on disposal of City owned property known as 807 Lee St.; Res. No. 169-2023, fixing Nov. 7, 2023 as date for public hearing on disposal of City owned property known as 215 N. Benton; Beer and/or liquor applications for: RE/MAX Pride, 2431 Northgate St., with OSA; Pallister Brothers Brewing Comp., 116 N. Market; all applications pending final inspections. Motion carried 4-1. Absent: Pope.

Mayor Johnson inquired if anyone from the audience wished to address an item on the agenda. There were none.

Galloway moved, seconded by McAntire that Res. No. 171-2023, auth. Greg Wilson d/b/a Integrity Golf Group, LLC to subcontract operations of Cedar Creek Golf Course to Adam Wilson, be passed and adopted. Much discussion was had. Motion Failed: 2-2-1. Ayes: Galloway, Hull. Nays: Roe, McAntire. Absent: Pope.

McAntire moved, seconded by Galloway that Res. No. 172-2023, amending Operating Agt. between City and Integrity Golf Group, LLC, to extend for an addtnl five yrs., be passed and adopted. Motion Failed: 0-4-1. Ayes: none. Nays: Roe, Galloway, McAntire, Hull. Absent: Pope.

Rath explained reasoning for holding PH is to be able to reallocate bond funds to purchase equip, from the golf course for future use. No objections rec'd. Hull moved, seconded by Galloway to approve pymt. to Alliant Energy in the amt. of \$13,833.72 for a new electrical transformer in Greater Ottumwa Park Campground. Motion carried 4-1. Absent: Pope.

Roe moved, seconded by Galloway that Res. No. 164-2023, approving changes/updates to Compensation Handbook, be passed and adopted. Motion carried 4-1. Absent: Pope.

Hull moved, seconded by Roe that Res. No. 167-2023, awarding contract and approving contract, bond, and cert. of ins. for Asbestos Abatement – City Hall Bldg. Project, be passed and adopted. PW Dir. Burgmeier reported Advanced Environmental Testing & Abatement, Inc. of Waterloo, IA in the amt. of \$95,000 was best bid. Motion carried 4-1. Absent: Pope.

McAntire moved, seconded by Galloway that Res. No. 170-2023, accepting work as final and complete and approving final pay request for WPCF Operations Roof Replacement Project, be passed and adopted. Burgmeier reported contract amt. \$163,953. Motion carried 4-1. Absent: Pope.

Hull moved, seconded by Roe that Res. No. 173-2023, removing Special Assessments totaling \$10,786 with interest and fees; applied to a vacant lot on Hackberry contained in the following Res: 252-2013, 291-2014, 268-2015, 286-2016, 267-2017, 284-2018, 266-2019, 260-2020, 209-2021 and 41-2023, be passed and adopted. Motion carried 4-1. Absent: Pope.

McAntire moved, seconded by Galloway that Res. No. 162-2023, auth. purchase of used equip. from Integrity Golf Group, LLC, for Golf Course Operations at Cedar Creek Golf Course, be passed and adopted. Motion Failed 1-3-1. Ayes: Galloway. Nays: Roe, McAntire, Hull. Absent: Pope.

Mayor Johnson inquired if anyone from the audience wished to address an item not on the agenda. Robert Hubbell addressed the Council on the drug trafficking that goes on in our City.

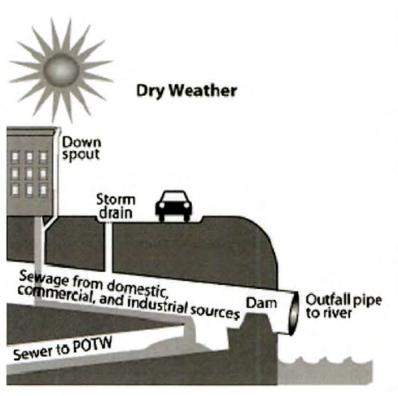


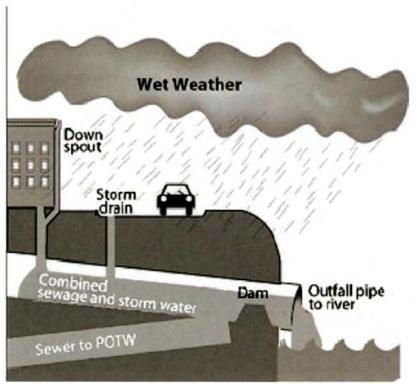

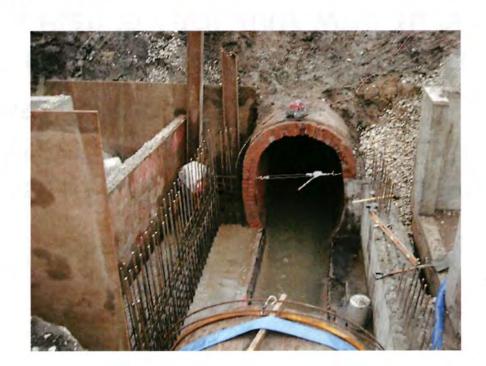

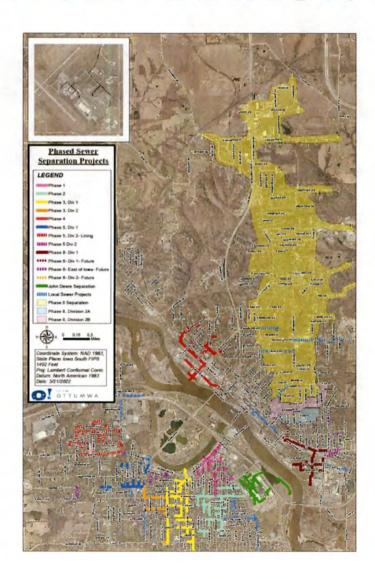

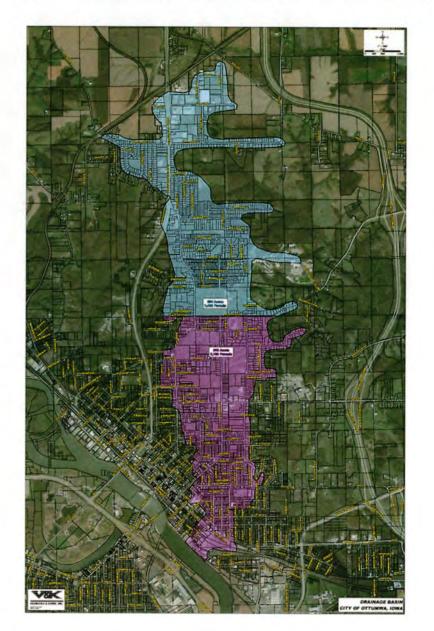






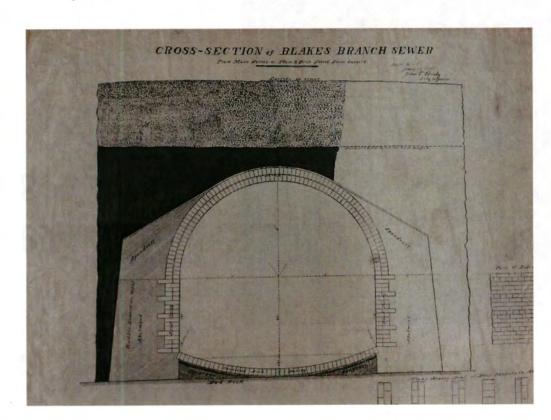

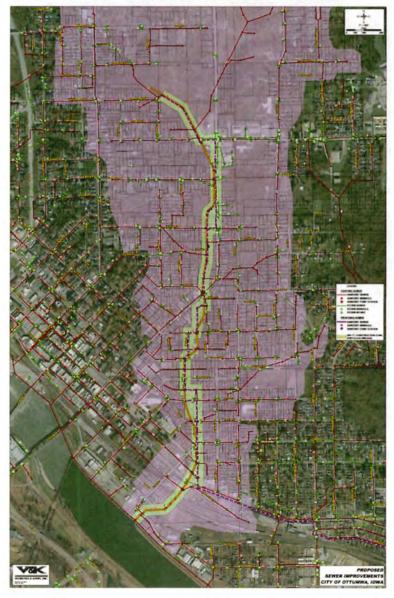

IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AGREEMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 GENERAL AVIATION VERTICAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM (GAVI)

THIS AGREEMENT is made between the Iowa Department of Transportation called the "Iowa DOT" and City of Ottumwa, hereafter the "SPONSOR".

1.00 PURPOSE:

The purpose of this agreement is to set forth terms, conditions and obligations for accomplishment of certain improvements at the **Ottumwa Regional Airport**, hereafter the "Airport".

Improvements shall consist of:

Construct T-Hangar, as more clearly defined in the project application.

It shall be referred to as the "Project" and shall be identified by

Project number: 91240OTM300 Contract number: CNTRT-00005796

2.0 GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 2.01 The SPONSOR shall have 90 days to sign and return this agreement or the Iowa DOT reserves the right to revoke this grant.
- 2.02 The SPONSOR shall have the project under contract no later than 12 months after the date of the agreement or the Iowa DOT reserves the right to revoke this grant.
- 2.03 The Iowa DOT agrees to reimburse the SPONSOR 55% of the eligible project costs, not to exceed the maximum amount payable of \$300,000 incurred according to the terms of this agreement. Reimbursement will be made in whole dollar amounts only, rounded down. Final payment request may include documentation of unreimbursed amounts due to rounding. Final reimbursement will be made up to the contract amount in whole dollars.
- 2.04 All projects meeting the definition of public improvements shall follow the competitive bid and competitive quotation procedures for vertical infrastructure as identified in Chapter 26 of the Code of Iowa and 761 Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 180. (https://www.legis.iowa.gov/docs/iac/chapter/761.180.pdf)
 - Competitive bid procedures for all projects greater than \$196,000.
 - Competitive quotation procedures for airport authorities and city sponsors with populations greater than 50,000 for projects between \$109,000 and \$196,000
 - Competitive quotation procedures for airport authorities and city sponsors with population of 50,000 or less for projects between \$81,000 and \$196,000,
 - Informal local procedures for projects less than the thresholds identified for competitive quotations.

The SPONSOR shall follow requirements of the Iowa Code Section 544A.18, 193B Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 5, Chapter 542B of the Code of Iowa, and 193C Administrative Code Chapter 1 to determine when professional engineering or architectural plans and specifications must be used. The SPONSOR shall submit any plans, specifications and other contract documents to the Iowa DOT for its files.

- 2.05 Should the SPONSOR fail to comply with any Condition or Assurance provided herein, the Iowa DOT may withhold further payment and may require reimbursement of any or all payments made by the Iowa DOT toward accomplishment of the Project.
- 2.06 The Iowa DOT shall not waive any right of authority by making payments pursuant to this agreement, and such payments shall not constitute approval or acceptance of any part of the Project.
- 2.07 Neither the Department nor the Sponsor intend to create rights in, and shall not be liable to, any third parties by reason of this agreement.
- 2.08 If any provision of this agreement is held invalid, the remainder of this agreement shall not be affected thereby if such remainder would then continue to conform to applicable law and the intent of this agreement.
- 2.09 The Iowa DOT shall determine what costs charged to the project account are eligible for participation under the terms of this agreement and the SPONSOR shall bear all additional costs accepted and paid. Only those eligible costs incurred after this agreement is executed shall be reimbursed, unless the SPONSOR receives written notice from the Iowa DOT that the Sponsor has authority to incur costs.
- 2.10 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this agreement, the Iowa DOT shall have the right to enforce, and may require the SPONSOR to comply with, any and all Conditions and Assurances agreed to herein.
- 2.11 The Iowa DOT's obligations hereunder shall cease immediately, without penalty of further payment being required, in any year for which the General Assembly of the State of Iowa fails to make an appropriation or reappropriation to pay such obligations, and the Iowa DOT's obligations hereunder shall cease immediately without penalty of further payment being required at any time where there are not sufficient authorized funds lawfully available to the Iowa DOT to meet such obligations. The Iowa DOT shall give the SPONSOR notice of such termination of funding as soon as practicable after the Iowa DOT becomes aware of the failure of funding. In the event the Iowa DOT provides such notice, the SPONSOR may terminate this agreement or any part thereof.
- 2.12 The SPONSOR is the contracting agent and, as such, retains sole responsibility for compliance with local, state and federal laws and regulations related to accomplishment of the Project. The sponsor shall ensure compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 STAT. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d-42 U.S.C. 2000d-4, and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to the end that no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving financial assistance from the Iowa DOT.

In accordance with Iowa Code Chapter 216, the SPONSOR shall not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color, creed, age, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, religion, pregnancy, or disability.

2.13 Funding will be available for reimbursement of the project for two years after the date of

the agreement, unless appropriations are withdrawn under 2.11. Assurances in this agreement remain in full force and effect for a period of 20 years from the date of the agreement.

- 2.14 The SPONSOR agrees to indemnify, defend, and to hold the Iowa DOT harmless from any action or liability out of the design, construction, maintenance and inspection or use of this project. This agreement to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless applies to all aspects of the Iowa DOT's application review and approval process, plan and construction reviews, and funding participation.
 - 2.15 In the case of any dispute concerning the terms of this agreement, the parties shall submit the matter to arbitration pursuant to the Iowa Code Chapter 679A. Either party has the right to submit the matter to arbitration after 10 days notice to the other party of the intent to seek arbitration. The written notice must include a precise statement of the dispute. The Iowa DOT and the SPONSOR agree to be bound by the decision of the appointed arbitrator. Neither party may seek any remedy with the State or Federal courts absent exhaustion of the provisions of this paragraph for arbitration.
 - 2.16 Infrastructure and/or work products developed through this grant become the property of the SPONSOR and the SPONSOR's responsibility to maintain.
 - 2.17 The attached Exhibit(s) will apply and are hereby made a part of this agreement:
 - Exhibit A, "Utilization of Targeted Small Business (TSB) Enterprises on Non-Federal Aid Projects (Third-Party State Assisted Projects)"

3.00 PROJECT CONDITIONS

2.18

3.01 The SPONSOR Agrees to:

- (a) Let contracts according to provisions of Chapter 26 of the Iowa Code and preside at all public hearings occasioned by the Project.
- (b) Contract for all professional and construction services as needed, submitting a copy of any engineering/consultant contract to the Iowa DOT. If the engineering/consultant agreement is more than \$150,000 and the sponsor will request state reimbursement for the engineering/consultant services, the agreement must be submitted to the Iowa DOT for pre-audit prior to execution of the agreement.
- (c) Establish and maintain a project schedule and provide the schedule to the Iowa DOT.
- (d) Obtain and provide the sales tax exemption certificates through the Iowa Department of Revenue and Finance to the successful bidder and any subcontractors to enable them to purchase qualifying materials for the project free of sales tax.
- (e) Submit to the Iowa DOT a Request for Reimbursement form, copies of invoices, and proof of payment for reimbursement. Progress payments are allowed.
- (f) Inspect work and equipment, test materials, and control construction to ensure that the design intent of the plans and specifications is achieved.
- (g) Inform the Iowa DOT of construction completion and allow the Iowa DOT access to review the completed project.
- (h) Certify satisfactory completion of the Project by resolution or signed final acceptance form and provide a copy to the Iowa DOT.

- (i) Retain all records relating to project cost, including supporting documents, for a period of three (3) years following final payment by the Iowa DOT, and to make such records and documents available to Iowa DOT personnel for audit.
- Ensure that applicable General Provisions and Project Conditions are included in any agreement between the SPONSOR and Engineer/Consultant.

4.00 SPECIAL PROVISIONS

4.01 The Project is for the sole purpose and use of aviation related activities and must be owned by the SPONSOR. The SPONSOR shall not lease airport space constructed with this grant to activities unrelated to aviation.

5.00 SPONSOR ASSURANCES

By authorizing execution of this agreement the SPONSOR hereby certifies that:

- It will not enter into any transaction which would operate to deprive it of any of the rights and powers necessary to perform any or all of the assurances made herein, unless by such transaction the obligation to perform all such covenants are assumed by another public agency found by the Iowa DOT to be eligible under the laws of the State of Iowa to assume such obligations and to have the power, authority, and financial resources to carry out all such obligations. If an arrangement is made for the management or operation of the Airport by any agency or person other than the SPONSOR or an employee of the SPONSOR, the SPONSOR will reserve sufficient rights and authority to insure that the Airport will be operated and maintained in accordance with these assurances. The SPONSOR retains responsibility for compliance with these assurances and all other provisions of this agreement, regardless of any arrangement for management or operation of the airport.
 - 5.02 It will not dispose of or encumber its title or other interests in the site and facilities during the 20-year period of this agreement.
 - 5.03 It will operate and maintain in a safe and serviceable condition the Airport and all facilities thereon and connected therewith which are necessary to service the aeronautical users of the Airport and will not permit any activity thereon which would interfere with its use for airport purposes.
 - Insofar as it is within its power and reasonable, the Sponsor will, either by the acquisition and retention of easements or other interests in or rights for the use of land or airspace and by the adoption and enforcement of zoning regulations, prevent the construction, erection, alteration, or growth of any structure, tree, or other object in the approach areas of the runways of the Airport, which would constitute an obstruction to air navigation according to the criteria or standards prescribed in Section 77.23 as applied to Section 77.25, Part 77, of the Federal Aviation Regulations. In addition, the Sponsor will not erect or permit the erection of any permanent structure or facility that would interfere materially with the use, operation, or future development of the Airport, or any portion of a runway approach area in which the Sponsor has acquired, or hereafter acquires.
 - 5.05 It will operate and maintain the facility in accordance with the minimum standards as may be required or prescribed by the Iowa DOT for the maintenance and operation of

such facilities as identified in the Iowa Administrative Code 761-Chapter 720.10.

- 5.06 It will operate the Airport as such for the use and benefits of the public. In furtherance of this covenant (but without limiting its general applicability and effect), the SPONSOR specifically agrees that it will keep the Airport open to all types, kinds, and classes of aeronautical use on fair and reasonable terms without unlawful discrimination between such types, kinds, and classes. The SPONSOR may establish such fair, equal, and not unjustly discriminatory conditions to be met by all users of the Airport as may be necessary for the safe and efficient operation of the airport. The SPONSOR may also prohibit or limit any given type, kind or class of aeronautical use of the Airport if such action is necessary for the safe operation of the airport or necessary to serve the civil aviation needs of the public. It will operate the Airport on fair and reasonable terms, and without unjust discrimination.
- 5.07 The SPONSOR will keep up-to-date and provide to the Iowa DOT an airport layout plan. The SPONSOR will not make or permit the making of any changes or alterations in the Airport or any of its facilities other than in conformity with the airport layout plan, if such changes or alterations might adversely affect the safety, utility, or efficiency of the Airport.

A Petition has been prepared which reflects signatures from at least 25% of all property owners within the proposed Ottumwa Downtown District as well as an assessed value equal to at least 25% of the property within the proposed district. After a review of the Petition, it appears that the initial requirements of the Petition have been met and have been confirmed. The next step for responding to the petition is to seek a recommendation from the City Planning and Zoning Commission. Their recommendation would be presented to the Council along with a proposed ordinance.

If approved by the City Council, properties located in the District would pay an additional property tax of \$1.00/thousand in Zone 1, \$2.00/thousand in Zone 2 and \$3.00/thousand in Zone 3. These funds are used for projects to benefit the district as determined by the SSMID committee. Previous projects include trash enclosure, the electric maintenance cart for Main Street Ottumwa, the dog waste bags near trash cans, ashtray replacement and support Business Builder Academy.

RESOLUTION NO. 179-2023

WHEREAS, the Petition contains the signatures of at least twenty-five per cent (25%) of all owners of the property within the Proposed District; and

WHEREAS, the Petition contains the signatures of owners representing ownership of property with an assessed value equal to twenty-five per cent (25%) or more of the assessed value of all the property within the Proposed District; and

WHEREAS, the property to be included in the Proposed District pursuant to the Petition is contiguous, wholly within the boundaries of the City, and is in districts zoned for commercial uses; and

WHEREAS, before taking action on the Petition, the Council is required by the Act to notify the City Planning and Zoning Commission and to receive an evaluative report from the Commission on the merit and feasibility of the project proposed in the Petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE OTTUMWA CITY COUNCIL THAT:

Section 1. The Petition is hereby determined to be sufficient and in compliance with the provisions of the Act.

Section 2. The Petition is hereby referred to the Plan and Zoning Commission, which Commission shall, with due diligence, prepare an evaluative report for this Council on the merit and feasibility of the project proposed in the Petition in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

PETITION TO CONTINUE THE DOWNTOWN OTTUMWA SELF-SUPPORTED MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 386, CODE OF IOWA (the "Act")

We, the undersigned, being at least 25 percent of all owners of property within the self-supported municipal improvement district proposed and hereinafter defined by this petition, and being owners of property within the proposed district having an assessed value of at least 25 per cent of the assessed value of all the property in the proposed district, hereby petition the City Council of the City of Ottumwa, Iowa, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 386 of the Code of Iowa (the "Act"), as follows:

2. To continue an operation fund with respect to the Proposed District to be known as the "Downtown Ottumwa Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District Operation Fund" (the "Operation Fund"), and levy an annual tax (the "Operation Tax") upon the property, as defined in the Act (excluding property assessed as residential property for property tax purposes) within the Proposed District (the "Property") for the purposes of:

(a) paying the administrative expenses of the Proposed District, as defined and authorized in the Act, or (b) paying part or all of the maintenance expenses of "improvements" or "self-liquidating improvements" as defined in the Act, with respect to the Proposed District, for a period of 7 years, commencing with the levy of taxes for collection in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and continuing for 6 additional years. The Operation Tax shall be levied annually upon the Property at the following rates:

Zone 1: a rate not to exceed \$1.00 dollar per thousand dollars of taxable value of the Property;

Zone 2: a rate not to exceed \$2.00 dollars per thousand dollars of taxable value of the Property;

Zone 3: a rate not to exceed \$3.00 dollars per thousand dollars of taxable value of the Property."

- 3. To disburse amounts collected in the Operation Fund to Main Street Ottumwa annually not before July 1 and no later than November 1 for one or more of the following purposes, at such times, in such amounts and under such conditions as shall be recommended to the City Council by a special SSMID Committee, composed of representatives of Main Street Ottumwa and the owners of property within the Proposed District:
 - a. Enhanced maintenance and cleaning of public spaces within the Proposed District, including but not limited to:

Maintenance of trees and seasonal plantings Sidewalk sweeping and power wash cleaning Cleaning public alleys and public spaces Graffiti removal Street and curb cleaning

b. Development and management of activities in support of marketing, business retention and attraction, including but not limited to:

Administrative fees of Main Street Ottumwa Staff
Conduct market analyses, business retention surveys and image surveys
Establish databases
Business counseling
Space referrals and assistance
Business-to-business communications program
District marketing materials
Miscellaneous business support services
Marketing activities, including media and advertising campaigns and communication pieces (calendar of events, newsletters, shopping directories, maps, holiday brochures)
Establishment and promotion of special events, festivals, and holiday activities in public spaces

c. Capital, physical or other improvements designed to enhance the image and appearance of the Proposed District, including but not limited to:

Streetscape and lighting improvements
Seasonal and holiday decorations
Signage and banners
Installation of seasonal plant materials and trees
Such other improvements as may be petitioned for by the owners
of property within the Proposed District under the Act

- 4. To require the SSMID Committee, as a further condition to the disbursement of funds from the Operations Fund, to submit to the Ottumwa City Council, no later than November 1 of each year, a budget showing, in general terms, proposed expenditures of such funds for the fiscal year beginning on the next July 1.
- 5. It is the further intent of this Petition that all taxes levied and collected on behalf of the Proposed District shall be expended for new, additional or enhanced services within the Proposed District, and that the City shall not diminish the type and extent of governmental services described in this Petition with the intention of transferring the cost of providing such services from the City budget to the Operation Fund.

6.
